### June 9, 2019 – Pentecost Sunday

**Pentecost:** Literally means 50<sup>th</sup>. It is a feast celebrated on the 50<sup>th</sup> day after the Passover feast by the Jews and a feast celebrated on the 50<sup>th</sup> day after the feast of the Resurrection of Jesus by the Christians. The Jewish Pentecost was originally a post-harvest thanksgiving feast. Later it was celebrated to remember God's covenants with Noah after the Deluge and with Moses at Mt. Sinai. On the day of Pentecost 1) The Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles and Blessed Virgin Mary as fiery tongues. 2) The frightened apostles were transformed into fiery preachers and evangelizers by a special anointing of the Holy Spirit. 3) The audience experienced a fresh anointing of the Holy Spirit with the gift of tongues, hearing Peter speaking in their languages. 4) The early Christians became powerful witnesses and brave martyrs for faith.

**Pentecost Sunday:** Marks the end of the 50 days of the Easter Season. The white veil has been removed from the crucifix, behind the altar, to commemorate the end of the Easter Season. The colour for Pentecost Sunday is red, symbolizing the Holy Spirit which appeared at Pentecost as tongues of fire. The Holy Spirit came as a strong wind. Another symbol of the Holy Spirit is the wind. The Holy Spirit gave the apostles the courage to preach the Gospel, marking the beginning of their ministry. Pentecost is the 'birthday' of the church.
