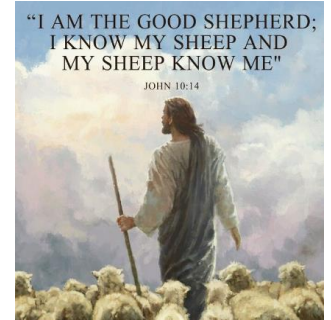
**4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter**

**First Reading** (Acts of the Apostles 4:8-12): Peter announces an act of healing in the name of Jesus Christ.

**Responsorial Psalm** (Psalm 118:1,8-9,21-23,26,28,29): A prayer of thanksgiving to God for his kindness

**Second Reading** (1 John 3:1-2): God revealed his love for us by calling us children of God.

**Gospel Reading** (John 10:11-18): Jesus says that he is the good shepherd who knows his sheep.



Sheep learn to recognize the voice of the one who feeds them, cares for them, protects them. The shepherd's voice seems to say: I am here for you because you are mine. As "the Good Shepherd," Jesus is totally committed to us, his sheep. He attends to our needs, willing to risk his own security to save us. His care for us seems to say: I am here for you because you are mine.

There are many alien voices in our world which, like wolves, are intent on destroying the flock of God. It's easy for us to be distracted by false shepherds and be lured into temptation. Jesus wants His "sheep" to know Him and recognize His voice. We need to practise listening to that still, small voice that comes to us in our prayer time, through our Bible reading, or through pictures and impressions that He gives us, so that we may stay close and not be led astray by the voice of a false shepherd.


**Prayer:** Lord Jesus, thank You that You do speak to me. Please help me to hear Your voice clearly and not be distracted by false shepherds. Amen.

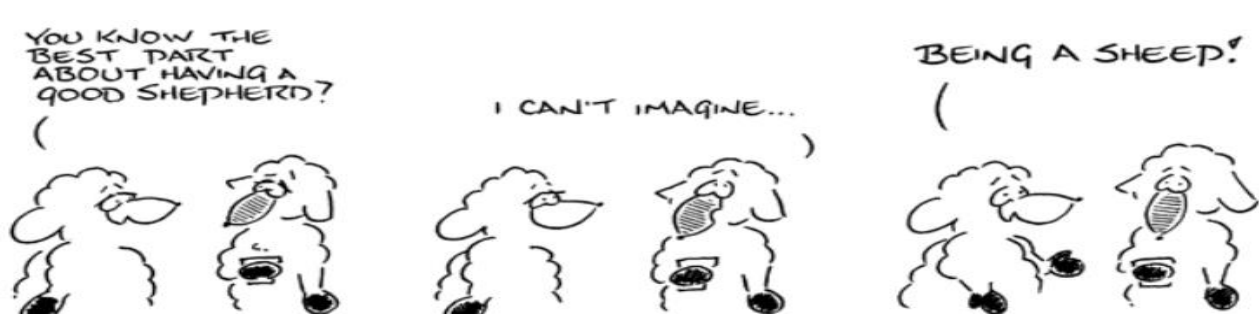
