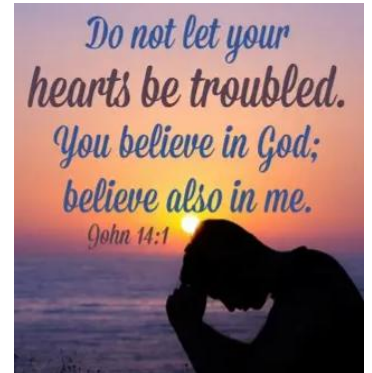
**CONFESSION:**  
 Half Hour before Mass

**First Reading (Acts 6:1-7):** The early Christian community chooses seven people to serve at table so that the Twelve can devote themselves to prayer and the ministry of the word.

**Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 33:1-2,4-5, 18-19):** The Lord is merciful toward those who trust in him.

**Second Reading (1 Peter 2:4-9):** Those who have faith are chosen in Christ to be a holy priesthood.

**Gospel Reading (John 14:1-12):** The connection between Jesus and his Father, between Jesus' work and the work of the Father, is made clear in today's Gospel. Jesus is in the Father, and God the Father is in Jesus. As God spoke his name to Moses, **"I am,"** so too Jesus speaks his name to his disciples: **"I am** the way and the truth and the life."
