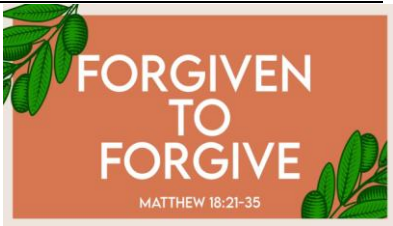

First Reading (Sirach 27:30—28:9): Those who seek God's mercy must be merciful toward others.

Responsorial Psalm (Psalm 103:1-4,9-12): A song of praise to God who is kind and merciful.

Second Reading (Romans 14:7-9): We belong to the Lord.

Gospel Reading (Matthew 18:21-35): Jesus teaches that we must forgive one another as God has forgiven us. There is a temptation to quantify forgiveness as Peter tried to do, but Jesus' point is that forgiveness is not about quantity—the number of times we extend forgiveness to another. In the parable the king's forgiveness is like God's forgiveness, and it transforms us, helping us to be as forgiving as God. The lesson is clear: If we hoard God's mercy while showing no mercy to others, we risk forfeiting the effects of God's mercy in our lives.

FORGIVENESS IS HUGE



Forgiveness is not merely a moral act—it is a divine power that releases the soul, restores relationships, and reflects the very nature of God. Forgiveness is a choice and not a feeling. One of the most freeing things we can do is to forgive; forgive others and forgive ourselves. Unforgiveness can actually make us physically sick. Forgiveness allows you to release anger, resentment, and bitterness, which can otherwise dominate your thoughts and emotions. Letting go of grudges can improve mental health, reduce anxiety, stress, and depression, and help you regain a sense of control over your life. It also helps you move out of "victim mode," allowing you to focus on personal growth and emotional healing rather than being consumed by past hurts. Sometimes forgiveness is not easy, but it is important. You may have to forgive 77 x 7 times until the pain disappears and the healing is complete. Forgiveness is emotional, and those tears are very healing because your heart is healing. *Forgive!*

Loving God, You call us to forgive as we are forgiven. Soften my heart toward those who have wounded me, releasing any bitterness or resentment. Help me to extend mercy and compassion, even when it is difficult, and guide me to peace and reconciliation. Amen
