1st Reading (Isaiah 55:6-9): God's ways are far beyond the ways of human beings.

Psalms (Psalm 145:2-3,8-9,17-18): God is near to those who call upon him.

2nd Reading (Philippians 1:20c-24,27a): Paul tells the Philippians to live for Christ.

Gospel Reading (Matthew 20:1-16): In the parable of the workers in the vineyard, Jesus teaches about God's generous mercy. The parable reminds us that although God owes us nothing, he offers abundantly and equally. We are occasionally tempted to think that our own actions deserve more reward, more of God's abundant mercy, than the actions of others. But God's generosity cannot be quantified or partitioned into different amounts for different people. When we think that way, we are trying to relate to God on our terms rather than to accept God's radically different ways.
